Who We Are

Competitive Marching Band – Perfect one show during the marching season and go to competitions on Saturdays in October. Perform at most Varsity Football Games.

The Starlets – Visual Color Guard of the band. Flag/Sabre/Rifle/Dance

Other Performing Components

- Concert Band
- Wind Ensemble (auditioned)
- 2 Jazz Ensembles (after school)
- Percussion Ensembles
- Winterguard (Starlets Indoor Competitive color guard)

ALL Wind and Percussion Players in the marching band are in Concert Band or Wind Ensemble class during the day.

FAQ's

1. If I take band class, am I required to be in Marching Band?

- Generally, YES, unless there is a conflict with Rehearsals and Competitions.
- STANDS ONLY OPTION for Wind Players (perform on Friday nights in the stands)
- PERCUSSION students are required to be in the Marching Band show.

2. How do I get an instrument?

- School Instrument rentals will be distributed at “Camps”

3. I play a fall sport/cheer, can I march the show?

- Sometimes. If the schedules conflict too much, STANDS ONLY option works best.

4. Is there a COST?

- YES. See expenses sheet.

5. Is there required “BAND CAMP” in the summer?

- YES!!!!!! Extremely important. See calendar of events.

6. I play drums, can I be on DRUMLINE?

- There is an audition process in May for DRUMLINE spots.

7. I play a fall sport/cheer, can I march the show?

- Sometimes. If the schedules conflict too much, STANDS ONLY option works best.

8. Are there required after school rehearsals and performances?

- YES. Co-Curricular class. After school rehearsals and performances are graded.

9. Is a job an excuse to miss rehearsals or performances?

- No, I would NOT recommend working during August-October.

The band typically plans one special performance or event every year. Every few years we try to plan a bigger trip. In the past we have performed in Washington D.C.(3 times), Savannah GA, Charleston SC, Universal Studios, Busch Gardens.

Robinson High School Marching Band Checklist for 2026-27 Season

Below is a list of tasks that need to be completed each month, if not sooner.

May:

- Complete the New Member Registration Form
- Complete Athletic Clearance after May 15th, 2026 (All new and returning students need to complete this. Students cannot participate outside until this is submitted and approved by school administrator.
 - The following NFHS Courses need to be completed by the student and certificates need to be submitted.
 - Concussion in Sports
 - Heat Illness Prevention
 - Sudden Cardiac Arrest
 - Signed Sports Physical form needs to be submitted for **Starlets Only**
 - Parents/Guardians need to complete a section as well before it can be submitted.
For full instructions, please see the detailed instruction sheet attached in this packet.
- Download the REMIND app.
 - Both Parents and Students need to sign up for Remind. It's our main communication method for updates and reminders for Band information.
 - Student REMIND: @rhsknights
 - Parent/Guardian REMIND: @rhsbandbg
- All new and returning students need to attend **Saturday Camp/Clinic on May 9th & May 16th from 9am to 1pm.**
- **Drumline Clinics** (new and returning members) will be held on **May 5th, May 12th & May 19th from 4:30 to 6:30.**

June:

- Attend summer rehearsals / clinics. Check the calendar. Students are expected to attend if they are in town.
- **Gebhardt Leadership Camp:** Only Leadership is expected to attend. (\$35)

July:

- Set up CUTTIME - a text link will be sent out once your student is registered for Band. This is where band fee obligations will be listed and payments can be made.
 - All students are REQUIRED to be in **Cutttime**.
 - At least one parent/guardian **must** be linked to the student account.
 - We recommend copying the link in the text message and sending it to your e-mail for reference.
 - Invoices/statements will be sent out monthly for those with outstanding balances.
- Make first or FULL PAYMENT for "General Band Fee", "Percussion Fee" or Starlet Fee in students' Cuttime account.
 - Band/Starlet fees can also be paid via cash or check (make checks payable to **RHS Band Boosters**) as well, and will be entered into Cuttime once the check has cleared. Partial payments are allowed but we would appreciate at least \$100 payment in July to help cover startup fees/snacks.
- Purchase NEW MEMBER Apparel Pack \$80 Cuttime/cash/check – Hat/Shorts/Shoes (Dinkles)/Water Cooler.
- 1 - Uniform "Knight Pride" shirt and 1 – "Show Shirt" are included as part of the Band Fee and will be distributed at the end of the month. Extra shirts and shorts may be purchased on the Band Store.
- Returning Members – Order/Pay for Dinkles if needed - \$35.00 (marching shoes). Once ordered, this fee will be added to your Cuttime account for payment. (Check/Cash also accepted.)
 - Returning members should order replacement hats or shorts if needed on the Band Store.
- HCPS Online Volunteer Applications for parents:
 - Volunteer Applications must be completed for any parents/guardians wanting to help at games, competitions or field trips for this school year. HCPS employees must also complete for RHS.

NOTE: Mr. Revett will have new and returning students try on shoes for size during practice in July.

August:

- Pay Uniform Fee (mypaymentsplus.com)
- Pay Instrument Rental Fee (mypaymentsplus.com) if you use a school instrument (includes Percussion)
- Pay August Band/Percussion/Starlet Fee Installment (Cutttime/Cash or Check)

September

- Pay September Band/Percussion/Starlet Fee Installment (Cutttime/Cash or Check)
- Rehearse A Thon Fundraiser – all students required to raise a minimum of \$200 – (Info to be provided in Aug.)

October

- Pay October Band/Percussion/Starlet Fee Installment (Cutttime/Cash or Check)
- Concert Uniform Orders –\$50 (Pants/Shirt/Tie) for Boys. \$65 (Dress) for Girls

November

- Pay last Band/Percussion/Starlet Fee Installment (Cutttime/Cash or Check)

ATHLETIC CLEARANCE

MANDATORY TO PARTICIPATE IN HIGH SCHOOL BAND OR COLOR GUARD

To complete clearance you will need:

Photo ID of Parent/Guardian Driver's License that matches the name on Medical forms you will complete.

3 NFHS Course Certificates (Save as PDF and upload into Athletic Clearance)

Parent/Guardian initials, signatures and information

Color Guard ONLY – Doctor's Physical

COMPLETE THE COURSE CERTIFICATE PROCESS (Must be completed every year)

Go to [NFHS Courses](https://nfhslearn.com) (nfhslearn.com)

Login or register.

FOLLOW REGISTRATION STEPS (Choose the correct school and select Music)

If you have completed this in the past, **Sign in**. If not, **register** for NFHS (You need an email, not student#@hcps.net) *Do not complete the courses unless you are registered and signed in to NFHS account.*

Once signed in, use the “Search our Products” bar at the top of the screen.

Search for each course **Concussion in Sports, Heat Illness Prevention, Sudden Cardiac Arrest**

Don't choose Band Safety

Once you find the correct course, move the cursor on top of the course and select **Start Learning**

On your Dashboard, go to **My Courses** and select the course you need to complete. “Begin Course”

Complete all 3 courses. *You can't skip through any of the steps or videos.*

Once finished with the course, find your completed **My Certificates** in the dashboard menu.

Save as a **PDF** or take a screen shot.

You will then need to upload certificates into Athletic Clearance below.

COMPLETE THE ATHLETIC CLEARANCE

If you have an account, login.

If you haven't registered before, create an account.

Select **Start Clearance Here**

Select **2026-2027**

Select **Robinson (Tampa)**

Select **BAND** (BAND AUXILLIARY *is for Color Guard members only.*)

Follow prompts and directions carefully and accurately complete everything.

Band Students DO NOT need to purchase insurance. SELECT NO.

Upload the 3 NFHS Certificates (PDF is BEST)

Upload PARENT ID (license). Same parent as the signatures and initials. (NOT STUDENT ID)

Color Guard members select the \$5 insurance for Auxilliary.

If it asks for proof of address, ie. Electric Bill, **disregard**. That is for sports only. Upload blank pdf.

Make sure you complete everything accurately before submitting.

Your Assistant Principal will CLEAR or DENY your submission.

Avoid issues by following all steps carefully.

**DO NOT COMBINE WITH SPORTS – COMPLETE BAND SEPARATELY.
DON'T MISS ANY PARENT/STUDENT SIGNATURE SPOTS**

2026-2027 Robinson Band Expenses

It is very important that student registration, uniform rental, and instrument rental are paid at the start of band camp. You may drop off payment in the office over the summer or any rehearsal.

Should financial difficulties arise; installments or other alternative payment plans can be arranged through the Band Boosters (before the season starts) Please contact the director for more information. **No student has been or will ever be excluded from participation in required band events for a legitimate hardship. You may be in jeopardy of not receiving your diploma or being allowed to walk at graduation if you owe money to the band and have not communicated.**

Volunteers Needed

Who can volunteer? Anyone over the age of 18 with an approved district volunteer application (see below)

What can I do? The band has a variety of fun volunteer opportunities to choose from

Where do I volunteer? Help is needed on the RHS campus, transportation, and events beyond the South Tampa area.

When should I volunteer? With the variety of options, you can volunteer based on your availability. There are day, evening, and weekend opportunities.

Volunteer Application

Volunteer clearance is required for any/all adults assisting on a HCPS school campus.

Level 1 volunteer application: for all adults wishing to assist on a school campus or with a school-sponsored event.

Level 2 volunteer application: for all adults wishing to chaperone overnight field trips or other school-related business. This process requires fingerprinting services.
